






Park Hotel Tsinandali




Republic






New Municipal Park in Batumi

The new park will preserve existing trees and add various new species of plants. Expansive 2-hectare recreation area will feature padel courts, a sports field, children's zones, relaxation areas, walking and cycling paths, and will naturally integrate into Batumi Boulevard.

The design of the park is being developed by the Danish company "MASU Planning".

Façade Engineering of Silk Towers – T1

For the Silk Tower project, our company is collaborating with the architectural company KKAA and the facade engineering company AKTII. They have developed the facade, which is inspired by the environment of Batumi and its surroundings.











Resilient Infrastructure and Efficient Use of Resources

We are providing a well-designed and flexible concrete skeleton that offers adaptability to evolving needs and requirements. The tower's rectangular shape and the arrangement of the cores in the central area contribute to a regular grid arrangement for the rest of the floor plan, which optimizes on-site efficiency and mitigates unforeseen challenges. Also, supported by thorough engineering studies – we aim to provide the most optimized quantity of concrete and dimensioning, to emphasize efficiency in resources.

Textured Finish

The exposed concrete pillars are both structural and the finish in the project. This creates a sense of duality and balance – a textured aggregate surface revealing the true nature of concrete, juxtaposed with a porous, tactile, ornamental surface to enhance the local craftsmanship. This draws attention to the details, revealing the beauty of the structure, in its true form. The choice of a mineral textured façade, echoing the roughness of natural materials, also engages in a seamless dialogue with the vegetation. This interplay between vegetation and minerals, a transformation metamorphosis takes place, revealing the structure's evolution into a mountainous surface.


